We're recruiting for a Psychometrist- FASD Assessment Clinic to join our team. This is a unique opportunity to work in a culture-based environment providing holistic health care.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Works under the clinical supervision of and in close collaboration with the clinical neuropsychologist to provide assessment services to children and youth (age 6-18) including:
 - chart reviews
 - behavioural observations
 - administration of various standardized neuropsychological tests and questionnaires (WISC-V/WAIS-IV, WIAT-III, Beery VMI/MC/VP, WRAML-2, D-KEFS, TEACH-2, CPT-3, TOMM, BRIEF-2, ABAS-3, Conners 3, BASC-3, MASC-2, CDI/BDI-2)
 - scoring of tests/questionnaires
 - summarizing test results in tables/appendix
 - contributing to report writing
- Participates in interdisciplinary team meetings and case conferences
- Ensures timeliness, accuracy, availability and security of information
- Familiar with and adheres to relevant legislation, standards of practice, codes of conduct, and guidelines (e.g., PHIPA, CYFSA, CPO Standard of Professional Conduct, Canadian Code of Ethics for Psychologists)
