The series will begin with Elder Kahontakwas Diane Longboat. Diane is a member of the Turtle Clan, Mohawk Nation at Six Nations Grand River Territory and a citizen of the Haudenosaunee Confederacy. She is a ceremonial leader, traditional teacher and healer. In the live-stream presentation titled *Tending to Spirit: Sharing Our Stories*, Diane will speak about the history of the land that brought her home, the meaning of the sacred fire, the transitions of the Soul of the Mother Lodge from a simple gazebo to the large ceremonial space that exists today, and the honour of hosting the many Elders and Knowledge Holders that will be speaking throughout the series.
