Bob Goulais is Anishinaabe from Nipissing First Nation. He is second degree member of the Three Fires Midewiwin Society and a committed advocate of Anishinaabe aadziwin – Indigenous ways of knowing and being. Bob is a sought-after speaker, traditional teacher, facilitator, and Master of Ceremonies, providing valuable cultural context and traditional knowledge to diverse audiences across Canada. In 2015, he founded Nbisiing Consulting Inc. that specializes in Indigenous community engagement.

Bob's storytelling presentation will be titled: "At the Beginning: The Fires of Creation." Bob will tell the story about the Creator, and the fires of Creation. This will include the creation of the universe, the concepts of spirit, energy, matter, Mother Earth, and the lowering of humankind. He will interweave traditional concepts, teachings, and storytelling to highlight the importance of spirit, spirituality, and our connection to Creation.
