Anishnawbe Health Toronto is a fully accredited community health centre which offers access to health care practitioners from many disciplines including Traditional Healers, Elders and Medicine People. We are recruiting a **Registered Practical Nurse (RPN)** to join our multidisciplinary team which addresses the social determinants of health. As an integral member of the multi-disciplinary team RPN will function with a focus on maternal, prenatal, postnatal and infant health.

We have broken ground for our new home of Anishnawbe Health Toronto, an Indigenous Hub in the West Don Lands. We expect to be completed in the spring of 2023. Join our dynamic team and the exciting programs and services offered at AHT and our collective work to support the reclamation of culture and identity.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Providing counselling, education, advocacy and health promotion as part of the Maternal Infant Program
- Providing appropriate health history, physical examination, and assessments
- Case management and home visits
- Well baby visits and parent/Infant health groups
- Lactation Education groups and individual one-to-one education/support
- Prenatal/Postnatal and infant nutrition groups

Qualifications:

- Member of the College of Nurses of Ontario in good standing and legally entitled to use the title of “Registered Practical Nurse (RPN)”
- Required to learn about Aboriginal culture, history, traditions, medicines and healing approaches
- Experience working with Aboriginal populations, Knowledge of Aboriginal culture, traditions, teachings and ceremonies; Aboriginal language skills an asset
- An understanding of the social determinants of health and other issues relevant to Aboriginal communities in Toronto; respect for Traditional Healing
- Strong work and organizational skills
- Advanced oral and written communication skills
- Strong consultation and collaboration skills
- Ability to function independently and in a team setting within profession’s established parameters
- Computer skills (minimum intermediate level) with PPS software knowledge is an asset
- Knowledge and appreciation of health and other issues facing Aboriginal communities such as the effects of the post-colonial and residential school syndrome
