Join our dynamic team and the exciting programs and services offered at AHT and our collective work to support the reclamation of culture and identity.

### Duties & Responsibilities:

- Utilize compelling case management and advocacy skills
- Extensive knowledge of community resources is required, including experience with systems and processes involved in mental health supports, income supports, legal matters, education and training as well as housing
- Work collaboratively with primary care practitioners to support follow up on care plans for clients across the life span. Case management will include accompaniments, assessment, and internal as well as external referrals
- Competency in facilitating and leading care service planning and service delivery that utilizes Aboriginal culture, history, values, and beliefs

- Provide individual and/or group counseling to support community members with mental health concerns
- Perform other related duties as assigned

- Strong understanding of counselling ethics, including consent, confidentiality, and boundaries
- Knowledge of community resources and supports in the Toronto area
