We are recruiting a Circle of Care Social Worker to join our multidisciplinary team which addresses the social determinants of health.

We have broken ground for our new home of Anishnawbe Health Toronto, an Indigenous Hub in the West Don Lands. We expect to be completed in the spring of 2023. Join our dynamic team and the exciting programs and services offered at AHT and our collective work to support the reclamation of culture and identity.

#### **Duties & Responsibilities:**

- Assessment, case management and coordination, counseling, advocacy, group work and, where appropriate, systemic advocacy
- Complete electronic charting on all clients records and service statistics; maintaining appropriate progress reports and ensuring clients records are up to date
- Supervision of a database system ensuring that information is collected, recorded, maintained and monitored for quality assurance

- Participation in and/or chairing consultations, case conferences, groups, family circles and other agency partnership collaborative events
- Partaking in research and training for all the unit's activities
- Performing other related duties as assigned

### **Qualifications & Experience:**

- BSW or minimum 2 years' experience in a social services setting, or an acceptable equivalent combination of education and experience
- Experience working with homeless clients
- Professional memberships and affiliations
- Knowledge of casework and case load supervision, case management and counseling
- Ability to work within a fast paced and multi-disciplinary team setting
- Knowledge and appreciation of societal issues and underlying health problems in the Aboriginal community, for example the intergenerational effects of the post-colonial and residential school experiences
- Computer literacy including skill with word processing, presentations and electronic charting software
- Ability to function independently and within established parameters
- Knowledge of Aboriginal language and culture is an asset
- Valid Ontario Driver's License is a requirement
