Anishnawbe Health Toronto is a fully accredited community health centre which offers access to health care practitioners from many disciplines including Traditional Healers, Elders and Medicine People. We are recruiting a Two-spirit Peer Support Worker to join our multidisciplinary team which addresses the social determinants of health.

We have broken ground for our new home of Anishnawbe Health Toronto and an Indigenous Hub in the West Don Lands. We expect construction of the new health centre to be completed in the Fall of 2023. Join our dynamic team and the exciting programs and services offered at AHT and our collective work to support the reclamation of culture and identity.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Assisting with the preparation and delivery of ceremonies, teachings and other cultural practices and interventions
- Maintaining the medicines under the guidance of the Healer and distributing the medicines
- Performing Peer Support Worker duties such as outreach peer support, mobile intake, program promotion and general health promotion to the Two-spirit community
- Assisting with data collection and program reporting
- Performing other related duties as assigned

Qualifications & Experience:

- Knowledge of Two-spirit identities and health issues that disproportionately affect this community
- Knowledge of Indigenous ceremonies, teachings and other cultural practices
- Peer support related training
- Experience with outreach and engagement, as well as community education, preferably with the Two-spirit community
- Strong desire and commitment to advocate for the mental health and wellness concerns of diverse Two-spirit populations and individuals
- Well-developed interpersonal, communication and teamwork skills
- Knowledge of Indigenous language and culture is an asset
- Computer proficiency
- Valid Ontario Driver's License is a requirement
