Anishnawbe Health Toronto is a fully accredited community health centre which offers access to health care practitioners from many disciplines including Traditional Healers, Elders and Medicine People. We are recruiting an **Community Mental Health Nurse (Registered Nurse)** to join our multidisciplinary team which addresses the social determinants of health.

We have broken ground for our new home of Anishnawbe Health Toronto, an Indigenous Hub in the West Don Lands. We expect to be completed in the fall of 2023. Join our dynamic team and the exciting programs and services offered at AHT and our collective work to support the reclamation of culture and identity.

Position Summary:

The position provides mental health interventions including triage, assessment, brief counseling and plans of care. These mental health services are in collaboration with Psychiatry and with the Nurse Practitioner based within the clinic, at outreach sites, at home visits, during client hospitalization and through mobile case management. The incumbent will monitor vitals and depot injections. Duties include completing electronic charting and participate in chart reviews, ethical reviews and case conferencing. The incumbent provides support in program planning and inter-agency liaison for community health and healing initiatives in the urban Aboriginal community including mental health promotion facilitating the delivery of community presentations and advocacy.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Licensed to practice as a Registered Nurse within the Province of Ontario
- Membership with RNAO
- Knowledge of the Indigenous community and culture is a prerequisite
- Experience in Psychiatric/Community Mental Health is required
- Education in the area of mental health and health promotion
- Knowledge and understanding of societal issues and underlying health problems in the Indigenous community, for example the effects of the post-colonial and residential school experiences and the high incidence of homelessness, addictions and traumatic stress
- Computer literacy including skill with word processing, presentations and electronic charting software
- Ability to function independently within established parameter
- Valid Ontario Driver's License is a requirement
